- 3. **Glider Familiarization Flight**. We have 40 spots for Cadets to participate in this year's Glider Familiarization Flight on Sunday, September 29. Cadets can sign up on Tuesday, September 17, 2019 and Tuesday, September 24, 2019. Cadets must sign-up in advance in order to attend. Priority will be given to cadets who have never gone gliding. More information can be found in Annex A on Page 6.
- 4. **Bagging Fundraiser.** On Saturday, October 5, 2019 and Sunday, October 6, 2019 we will be having our first bagging fundraiser of the training year at the Marché Adonis Place Vertu located at 3100 Boulevard Thimens, Montréal, QC H4R 0C9. We are looking for cadets to do at least one (1) shift during the weekend. We are hoping to raise \$2,500.00 to support our activities for the upcoming training year. - 5. **Ground School Program.** The Ground School program will start on Thursday, September 26, 2019 and will hold training sessions every Thursday from 1900 hours 21000 hours until February. This program is open to all Level 3 Level 5 Cadets who intend to apply for Glider Pilot or Power Pilot summer courses. Participation in this program is a mandatory requirement to apply for either of these courses.
- 6. **Band (Music) Program.** The Music program is accepting new musicians. Interested cadets should speak with FCpl Wu. Practices are on Saturdays from 0900 hours 1200 hours at the Centre des Loisirs Saint-Laurent. No music experience is required, just a desire to learn.

GLIDER FAMILIARIZATION - SEPTMEBER 29, 2019

- 1. On Sunday, September 29, 2019 Eric Simms will have the opportunity to participate in a glider familiarization flight. The aim of the glider familiarization flying program is to provide each air cadet with at least one glider flight per year. These flights are the first building block of an Air Cadet's aviation experience, and cater to Air Cadets inexperienced in aviation. Familiarization flights are benign flights that introduce the cadet to the joy of flying, giving them the opportunity to actually fly an aircraft, and hopefully instill a desire to experience aviation in more depth.
- 2. **Arrival Time.** All cadets must be at the squadron, 1415 rue Filion, for 0730 hours on Sunday, September 29, 2019.
- 3. **Transportation**. Cadets will be transported by bus to and from the training location.
- 4. **Meals.** Breakfast and lunch will not be provided. We recommend that cadets have a good breakfast before arriving at the squadron. All cadets need to bring a cold lunch for the day. There are no restaurants or facilities with microwaves available at the training location.
- 5. **Dress.** Cadets will be in appropriate civilian clothes. They will be outside all day, therefore, it is important that they are dressed for the weather. All Cadets are asked to bring a sweater or fall jacket as it might be a little cold in the glider during the flight.
- 6. **Pick-up Time and Location.** Cadets will be returned to the squadron, 1415 rue Filion. Cadets will be returning between 1500 hours and 1700 hours. The end time for the activity will be determined by the Gliding Centre on the day of the activity. We ask that all parents be available during these times to pick up their child. Cadets will call home before leaving the gliding site.
- 7. **Health Cards.** All Cadets must bring their Health Card. They will be responsible for having their card on them at all times.
- 8. Rain-out (Weather) Cancellation. Gliding is very much weather dependent. In the event the activity has to be cancelled a message will be put on Facebook and a call-out will be completed on Sunday morning. Please make sure we have a phone number to reach you on Sunday morning. In the event of cancellation, the activity will be rescheduled.
- 9. Cadets can sign up for this event through their Flight Commander or their Section Leader. We ask that Cadets RSVP, yes or no, by September 24. We only have 40 spots available to cadets, priority will be given to cadets who have never gone gliding.

L'Auto Cadet Fundraising Campaign 2019-2020

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

This year our Cadets will be participating in the L'Auto Cadet Fundraising Campaign organized by the Quebec and Ottawa Valley Provincial Committee of the Air Cadet League of Canada. As part of the enrolment conditions, every Cadet and Parent/Guardian agreed to participate in the fundraising activities of our Squadron. Therefore, it is expected that each Cadet and their parent(s)/guardian(s) will do their part by participating in this fundraising campaign. With your help in this fundraising effort we will be able to continue to offer our wide range of activities without the need to charge Cadets fees to participate, and to continue to build a stronger Squadron by updating our training equipment and other necessary resources.

This year we are asking that each Cadet sell at least three (3) booklets of tickets. The Cadets enrolled in the Ground School program will be required to sell a minimum of four (4) booklets. However, we do encourage all Cadets to go above this minimum requirement if they are able to do so. This is the primary means that we use to notify the lottery winners. It is therefore very important to make sure we fill out the ticket stubs correctly and that we don't lose any of the stubs.
