## **FALL SURVIVAL WEEKEND 26-27 OCTOBER 2019**

588 Eric Simms will be conducting a Survival Weekend in Saint Wenceslas on 26-27 Oct 19. This is a **MANDATORY** activity for all cadets as each cadet is required to attend survival weekends as part of their required training each year. Cadets will be learning a variety of skills and knowledge about how to survive in the wilderness.

KEY INFORMATION	
Arrival time:	All Cadets should arrive at the squadron (1415 rue Filion) for 1800 hours on 25 Oct 19 (Friday). The bus will depart for the training site at 1830 hours promptly.
Transportation:	Cadets will be transported to and from the training location from the squadron by bus.
Meals:	Meals will be provided. Cadets will be eating military issued Meals Ready to Eat (MRE) packages. Those cadets with special dietary requirements or food allergies are asked to indicate this information on the permission slip and return it to the squadron no later than 22 Oct 19 in order to allow for any special accommodations to be made.
Clothing and Equipment:	Cadets are required to bring the clothing and equipment listed on the Equipment Checklist on the back of this page. This list is designed to ensure that cadets are safe and comfortable in the field, but also that they do not pack too much and are burdened by having to carry too much stuff with them in the woods. Cadets not dressed appropriately or without the proper footgear for the weather will be sent home.
Health Card & Medication:	Cadets are required to have their health card with them in order to participate in the activity (this will be checked before the cadets leave for the training site). Cadets should also bring any prescription medications with them in the original pill bottle. Cadets will be administered their medications during the weekend as needed. Cadets with puffers or Epipens must have them on their person at all times during the weekend.
Pick-up Time:	Cadets can be picked up at the squadron (1415 rue Fllion) at 1600 hrs on 27 Oct 19 (Sunday).
Requests to be Excused:	This is a mandatory activity and will count towards a cadet's completion of their mandatory training program. All Cadets are expected to submit their permission slip, signed by their parent/guardian, to their Flight Commander no later than 22 Oct 19.

This is a mandatory parade and all Cadets are expected to attend unless they have been excused for a valid reason.

### **KEY INFORMATION**

Arrival Time.

All Cadets should arrive at the Municipal Parking Lot located on rue Ouimet across from the Fire Station 73, just north of rue de l'Eglise at 1000 hours. See the map below. Cadets are asked to be on time as the surrounding streets may be closed in advance of the parade.



Dress: Cadets will be required to be in the C1 (tunic, shirt with tie, and medals). Recruits or

those without a complete uniform are to wear dark pants, a white dress shirt and running shoes. Cadets will be outside, so they are to wear their Cadet All-Season Jacket, or a

Conservative Civilian Jacket if they have not been issued one.

**Pick-up Time:** Cadets can be picked up after the parade at the Municipal Parking Lot located on rue

Ouimet across from the Fire Station 73 at 1145 hours.

**Other:** It is strongly recommended that all Cadets eat breakfast before coming to the activity.

Avoid heavy or greasy foods. Toast with peanut butter or jam, cereal or oatmeal, fruits

are all good options.
